1. A minimum non-refundable deposit of \$200 shall accompany this application.
2. Early-Bird Rate: Must be registered by May 10, and paid in full by May 31, 2024. Balances remaining after May 31 will be priced according to the "After April 31" rates.
3. Extra Early-Bird Discount: Register before April 5, 2024 for an additional \$50 discount per child.
4. **REFERRAL DISCOUNT!!** \$100 off your tuition for each new family you refer that signs up for at least 2 weeks! A "new family" is considered a family who has not attended Gan Israel of Roslyn since 2020. They must indicate you as their "referrer".
5. Sibling Discount: 5% off total family base tuition – not optional programs. Discount only applies for full 6 or 7 week enrollment.
6. Shirt & Hat Fee: \$20 per child will be added to your total tuition to pay for the official Camp T-shirt and hat. Camp T-shirt must be worn on trip days (see schedule). Child not wearing camp shirt on a trip day will be given a new one and charged \$10.
7. Regular Refund Policy: In the event of camper withdrawal from program, tuition total will be recalculated according to number of weeks attended (partial week counted as "week"), based on "Individual Weeks Rate" at time of withdrawal, and refund will be issued accordingly. No credit or refund will be granted for absent days. In the event of full consecutive 'camp week' (Monday-Friday) or more of absence, refund will be granted as above.
8. The camp reserves the right to terminate enrollment of any camper who does not demonstrate reasonable age appropriate standards of behavior (as determined by the camp). Refund will be calculated as above.
9. A completed medical form shall be in the possession of Camp Gan Israel before May 31. By order of the Health Department, a child will not be allowed in camp without a completed medical form on file.
10. In case of medical emergency, camp staff has permission to treat camper as deemed appropriate.
11. Permission is granted to use photographs and videos taken of children for promotional purposes.
12. Consent is granted to take child off camp grounds for swimming and excursions, as part of camp activities.
13. Camp staff has authority to sign, on behalf of parent or guardian, any waivers required to participate in scheduled trips & activities.
14. The one signing this contract takes full responsibility for all tuition payments, and any credit card auto-charge payment plans that are chosen in the online portal. I agree that I will not cancel or dispute any payment plan after its associated session has begun.
15. This contract is to be considered valid and binding when signed electronically in the online registration portal by parent or guardian.

Rights and Responsibilities of Camp Operators:

- 1) To inform you and the local health department if your child is involved in any serious injury, illness or abuse incident.
- 2) To screen the background and qualifications of all staff.
- 3) To train staff about their duties.
- 4) To provide supervision for all campers during hours of operation for day camps.
- 5) To maintain all camp physical facilities in a safe and sanitary condition.
- 6) To provide safe and wholesome meals.
- 7) To have and follow required written plans for camp safety, health and fire safety.
- 8) To notify the parent or guardian, that the camp is required to be permitted to operate by Nassau County Department of Health; the camp is required to be inspected twice yearly; and the inspection reports concerning such camps are filed at: 200 County Seat Drive, Mineola, New York 11501.
